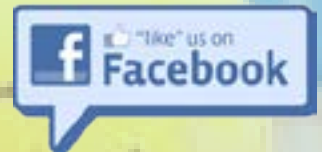

The Boys & Girls Clubs specialize in working exclusively with youth. Our professional staff are highly dedicated and trained to provide the best possible summer camp experience for your children. We also put great effort into recruiting and training individuals who have experience working with youth and who will make excellent role models for your children. The result is that our Summer Camp programs not only provide a fun and safe summer experience, but also challenge your children and offer them many opportunities to grow. Our professional staff provide a safe and fun environment which encourages youth to develop positive self-esteem, values, and skills.

Registration Information

All registrations will be accepted ONLINE only at our website www.kirkland.positiveplace.org. All you need to do is log onto our website and choose the programs you would like to register your child/ren for. Each week of camp that is offered is listed as a SEPARATE program, so be sure to select ALL the weeks that you intend your child/ren to participate in. See page 8 for a step by step process for registration.

Membership

Our membership fee is \$50. Membership goes from 9/1-8/31.

Summer Camp Fees

The balance for weekly camp fees are due the **MONDAY** prior to the start of camp (e.g. the balance for week #2 is due the Monday of week #1). Reservations and deposits will be forfeited if the camp balances are not paid 7 days prior to camp.

There is **NO PRORATING OF FEES** should your child not be at the camp for one or more days during the session.

All deposits are nonrefundable/nontransferable. So be sure to register accordingly. Camp fees are formulated to cover the cost of staff and supplies and are based on the minimum number of participants. Children enrolled in the program are reserving time, space, supplies and staff regardless of attendance.

Refunds for Summer Camps

All summer camps have a \$25 nonrefundable deposit. To receive partial refund, all participants must cancel one week prior to the beginning of the session they are registered for. Failure to cancel a program before its start date will result in no refund of fees.

Payment Options

The Kirkland Boys & Girls Club accepts Visa/Mastercard, check, cash or money orders. There will be a \$35 fee on all returned checks. If at any time a NON-SUFFICIENT FUNDS check is written from your account, your child will not be allowed to participate in the session until the delinquent fees are paid in full.

All-Star Sports Camp

Campers will play the originals like basketball, soccer, and kickball plus sports like badminton, ultimate frisbee, and foosketball. We will play in the gym and outside on our field. There will even be a girls only week and a co-ed outdoor week.

Basketball
