Club Rules:

- ✓ Be Safe:
 - O No running or throwing anything.
 - O Alcohol, drugs, and firearms are prohibited. If you appear to be under the influence, you will be removed from activities and a parent will be contacted.

✓ Be Respectful

- No PDA (Public Displays of Affection)
- Keep your hands to yourself.

✓ Be Responsible:

- Once you leave the building, you may not re-enter. Please stay inside the building. This is a drop-in program so teens may leave at any point but they WILL NOT be allowed to re-enter the building.
- Use 3rd floor restrooms only.
- NO GUM ALLOWED.
- The late night ends at 10:00PM. Please arrange pick up no later than 10pm.

DRESS CODE EXPECTATIONS

The following guidelines should aid parents and members in selecting the proper attire for the BGC. We follow the Mercer Island School District's dress code.

- ✓ Tank top straps must be at least three fingers width
- ✓ No midriff showing
- ✓ Shorts and skirts must be fingertip length
- ✓ Shoes must be worn at all times
- ✓ Clothing that displays tobacco, drugs, alcohol, obscenities, or sexual innuendoes are unacceptable.
